ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1342**, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AN UNNAMED ALLEY/THOROUGHFARE IN BARANGAY MASAGANA, PROJECT 4, QUEZON CITY, AFTER THE FORMER DECEASED BARANGAY CAPTAIN JOSE M. FLORES.

Introduced by Councilors DIORELLA MARIA SOTTO-DE LEON, JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, FRANZ S. PUMAREN, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO.

WHEREAS, Section 13 (b) (2) of the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes the sangguniang panlungsod of highly urbanized cities, in consultation with the National Historical Institute (NHI), to name streets, thoroughfares and bridges;

WHEREAS, there are alleys/thoroughfares located in Project 4, particularly in Barangay Masagana, which bears no name and, therefore, naming is a necessity;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Masagana, have adopted a Barangay Resolution requesting the Quezon City Council to name an alley/thoroughfare located between Callejon Conchu and J. Perez Streets to Brgy. Capt. Jose M. Flores Alley;

WHEREAS, naming the alley/thoroughfare in Barangay Masagana after former Barangay Captain Flores is a fitting tribute to him as he has contributed to the development and progress of said barangay.
