AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LIVELIHOOD TRAINING CENTER FOR EVERY DISTRICT IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, one way of uplifting the lives of the City's inhabitants is for the Quezon City government to encourage them to engage in livelihood projects;

WHEREAS, the government must, however, provide the place and the facilities where the residents may acquire the necessary skills and know-how to be able to succeed in their chosen fields;

WHEREAS, teaching the residents the skills in livelihood projects such as hair culture technology, cosmetology, food trades, baking arts and crafts and other vocations is a lasting legacy from the City government which they will cherish for the rest of their lives.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. A Livelihood Training Center is hereby mandated to be established for every district in Quezon City in any place/site owned by the City government to be determined by the City Mayor.
