ORDINANCE NO. SP-1363, 13-2003

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE QUEZON CITY SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL AS THE CITY'S PREMIER HIGH SCHOOL, PROVIDING INCENTIVES FOR ITS STUDENTS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Science High School, a public high school with special curriculum located at Misamis Street, Bago Bantay, within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City, has been declared as the regional science high school for the National Capital Region by virtue of Department of Education, Culture and Sports Order No. 58, Series of 1999, in consonance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 8496, otherwise known as "An Act to Establish the Philippine Science High School System and Providing Funds Thereof";

WHEREAS, the said high school with a population of nine hundred (900) students continues to live up with its expectation as the "creme de la creme" not only within the region but also nationwide and continues to bring honor to the government of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, since its inception and even up to the present, the said high school continues to be supported by the City government of Quezon City through its leadership from the Honorable Mayor, Vice Mayor and to the Councilors, not to mention the efforts exerted by the respectable members of Congress representing the four districts of the City;

WHEREAS, in order to continue the tradition of looking after the general welfare of the students of the said school which definitely will alleviate their condition as students, the City government must signify its firm commitment to support the said school all throughout;

WHEREAS, in order to formalize this lifetime partnership, the City government must adopt the said school and as such provide the necessary incentives such as the grant of monthly allowance of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) for every student for ten (10) months.
