ORDINANCE NO SP- **1405**, S-2004

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) OR SO MUCH THEREOF, FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION/ERECTION OF ANDRES BONIFACIO MONUMENT/STATUE IN NOVALICHES PUBLIC PLAZA, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Andres Bonifacio, the famous head of Katipunan, played an important role against Spanish Colonialism during the early days of the Philippine Revolution;

WHEREAS, in the struggle for freedom, Andres Bonifacio recruited some Novaleños including Colonels Geronimo, Luis Malinis and Canuto Dumalay that eventually led to the restoration of Philippine democracy;

WHEREAS, in honor and in recognition of his heroic acts especially to the people of Novaliches, Andres Bonifacio deserved to have a statue in Novaliches Plaza along with the monument of Dr. Jose P. Rizal;

WHEREAS, the erection of Andres Bonifacio Monument in Novaliches Public Plaza will not only perpetuate the memory of a great man, but also serve as a remembrance for the idealist young generation.
