ORDINANCE NO. SP. 2092 , S-2011

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING 2012 AS "TANDANG SORA YEAR", COMMENCING A YEAR-LONG CELEBRATION STARTING JANUARY 6, 2012 UP TO THE END OF THE SAID YEAR AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 15 and 16 of the 1987 Constitution provide respectively that, the State shall conserve, promote and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations; that all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the cultural treasure of the nation and shall be under the protection of the State which may regulate its disposition;

WHEREAS, Melchora Aquino de Ramos who was born on January 6, 1812 and died on March 2, 1919, was a "Filipino revolutionary who became known as "Tandang Sora" in the history of the Philippines because of her advanced age when the Philippine Revolution broke out in 1896;
