AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUBDIVISION PLAN WITH ONE HUNDRED NINETY ONE (191) LOTS, UNDER A COMMUNITY MORTGAGE PROGRAM (CMP) PROJECT CONSISTING AN AREA OF TEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY (10,430.00) SQUARE METERS COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NUMBERED N-338214 OF THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS OF QUEZON CITY, REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF CARLOTA C. SYQUIA, ET. AL., LOCATED AT LOT 2, (LRA) PCS-36513, LANGKA ST., GROUP 1, AREA B, BARANGAY PAYATAS, QUEZON CITY, METRO MANILA, AS APPLIED FOR BY THE HILLSIDE VILLAGE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT MRS. VIOLETA A. ESPINOSA, PURSUANT TO THE IMPLEMENTING STANDARDS, RULES AND REGULATIONS OF QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-56, S-93 AND BATAS PAMBANSA BILANG 220.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council under the Local Government Code of 1991 is empowered to approve subdivision plan for residential, commercial and industrial purposes;

WHEREAS, strict observance of the standards and requirements set by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Batas Pambansa Bilang 220, on the submitted plan, as applied for by the Hillside Village Homeowners Association, Inc., the proposed subdivision plan shows that the minimum saleable lots are within the revised minimum standard of 28.00 square meters. Generally, this project is in compliance with the minimum requirements of the Implementing Standards, Rules and Regulations of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-56, S-93 and Batas Pambansa Bilang 220.
