ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2129, S-2012

AN ORDINANCE UPGRADING AND REORGANIZING THE URBAN POOR AFFAIRS OFFICE INTO A DEPARTMENT TO BE KNOWN AS THE HOUSING, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND RESETTLEMENT DEPARTMENT, PROVIDING FOR ITS REVISED/ NEW ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN, DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
