ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2316**, S-2014

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CITY ARCHITECT DEPARTMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR AND DEFINING ITS ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

WHEREAS, realizing the crucial role of the Architect in community and urban renewal development, Section 454, sub-section (b) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the creation of the City Architect with the relevant functions defined in Section 485, Article 7;

WHEREAS, being a highly urbanized community with an accelerated phase of Urban Renewal and Development, the Quezon City government needs to ensure that a "socio-architectural" community development and changes are executed based on sound architectural design and standards;


WHEREAS, the Architect plays a crucial role in the realization of a well executed Urban Renewal Development by applying his professional expertise in the art and science of developing design concepts, planning for functional relationships and intended uses and establishing the form, appearance, aesthetics, and construction details, enlargement, or alteration of a building or environs intended for human use or occupancy;

WHEREAS, the current set-up being a Division in the Department of Engineering hinders the professional involvement of the Architects in exercising its core functions of planning, design, functional relationships, etc. in the realization of abstract ideas into tangible and meaningful creation and ensuring compliance to architectural design specifications and details of infrastructure projects of the City government;

WHEREAS, realizing the inherent desire to develop a well conceptualized and aesthetically designed urban projects based on sound and acceptable architectural principles, the Quezon City government created an Ad Hoc organization called the Special Design Group (SDG) to complement the existing Architectural Division;

WHEREAS, the leadership of the QC Government recognizes the importance of a meaningful urban and community development when it directed the restructuring of SDG to serve as the core organization of the Office of the City Architect.

WHEREAS, under Section 454 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is empowered to 'create such other offices as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of the City Government; x



NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Creation – *There is hereby created a unit which shall be known as the "City Architect Department (CAD).*

SECTION 2. HEAD OF OFFICE – *The newly-created Department shall be headed by a City Government Department Head III who shall also be known as the City Architect.*


SECTION 3. QUALIFICATIONS – *The City Architect shall be a citizen of the Philippines, a resident of Quezon City, of good moral character, and a Licensed Architect. He must have acquired experience in the practice of his profession for at least five (5) years.*

SECTION 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS – *The City Architect Department shall have the following functions:*


a. Generally, shall be accountable for translating the infrastructure requirements of the City into an architectural design and specifications with consideration to the environment and the public at large and compliant with the standards required in the National Building Code of the Philippines.

b. Specifically, shall be responsible for:

b 1. development of design concepts, its planning for functional relationship and intended uses,

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- b.2. determination of the form, appearance and aesthetics;
- b.3. preparation of construction details;
- b.4. conversion and interpretation of urban plan into a functional and aesthetically - designed community suitable for human use;
- b.5. coordinate with the appropriate agency/entity involved in the aesthetics and the maximum utilization of the land and water within the jurisdiction of the City government to be compatible with environmental integrity and ecological balance;
- b.5. formulation of economic or feasibility studies, selection of site location, design analysis & micro-land use, architectural programming, research and development of construction technology and selection of the applicable construction materials; and
- b.7. ensure compliance to architectural plans, specifications and diverse costs of construction projects. *



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SECTION 5. ORGANIZATION – The organization set-up of the City Architect Department (CAD) including the Qualification Standards (the proposed organization and qualification standards are reflected in the attached schedule Annexes A & A-1) shall conform to the requirements of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Civil Service Commission (CSC).


SECTION 6. STAFFING REQUIREMENTS -- The filling up of positions in the newly created CAD shall be in accordance with the provisions of CSC on merit and fitness.

SECTION 7. FUNCTIONAL RE-ALIGNMENT -- The functions of the Architectural Division, Department of Engineering shall be absorbed by the newly created CAD once approved by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM). The reorganization shall not result in the termination of services of incumbent personnel of the Architectural Division, Department of Engineering as they may be either absorbed in CAD or retained in the Department of Engineering.

SECTION 8. FUNDING -- The capital expenditures, maintenance and other operating budgets of the newly-created office shall be included in the regular annual budget of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE - All Quezon City Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders, Memorandum Circulars and Administrative Regulations, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of the Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


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SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – *This Ordinance shall take effect after its complete publication.*





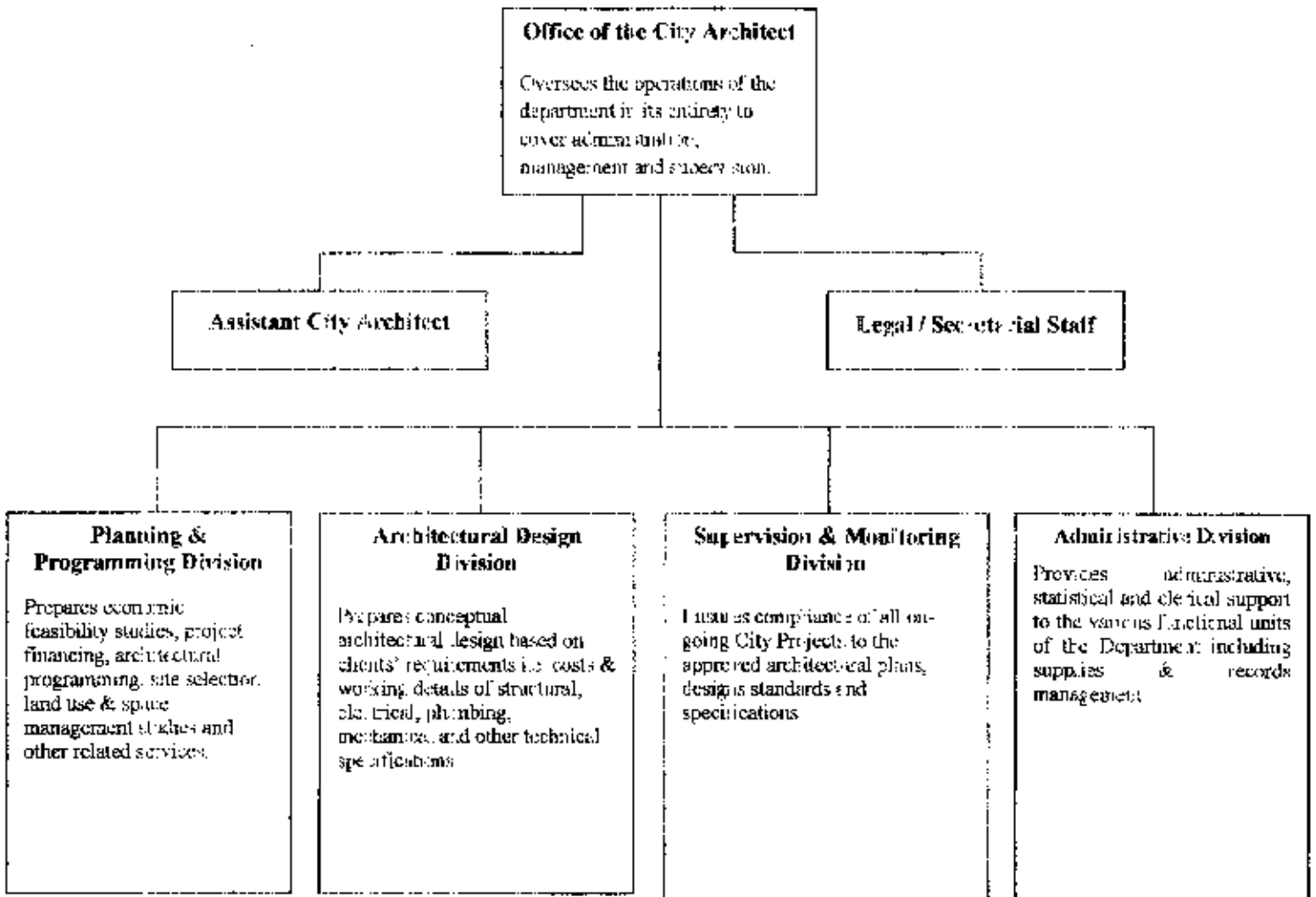
