WHEREAS, as clear manifestation of its support to the BSP-Quezon City Council, the City Government intends to increase the admission fees in all the cinemas in the city by One Peso (P1.00), thereby, in the process, paving the for in the realization of the mission and vision of the scouting movement in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, prominent among the activities and services conducted by this Council, are those which are geared towards the promotion of the moral, spiritual and physical well-being of the youth, the development of sports and livelihood, and in assisting the promotion of the environment and waste management program and community development of the City Government, among many others;


WHEREAS, the BSP-Quezon City Council, has been involved not only in promoting character development, providing adequate citizenship training and leadership among the Filipino Youth of the City, but inculcating in them love of country, civic consciousness and responsibility, courage and discipline and similar other virtues and moral values.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Admission Fees in all cinemas/ movie houses in Quezon City are hereby increased by One Peso (P1.00) covering the month of September 2015.

SECTION 2. All concerned movie/ cinema owners and operators are hereby authorized to transmit and turn-over to the BSP-Quezon City Council all sums of money collected and the BSP-Council will account for all such money received and submit to the City Treasurer of Quezon City, official receipts and such other pertinent records as maybe required in the acknowledgment thereof, subject to the usual accounting regulations. The City Treasurer is directed to submit the corresponding report to the City Council in connection therewith. x






