ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2474**, S-2016

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING P. TUAZON EXTENSION, BARANGAY ESCOPA II, QUEZON CITY AS NO ENTRY ZONE FOR HEAVY VEHICLES WITH MORE THAN FOUR (4) WHEELS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (v) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances to regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (vi) of the same law likewise empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to approve ordinances that regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and when necessary in the interest of public welfare;
