ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2488** , S-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-2069, S-2011, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN (CLUP) 2011 TO 2025.

WHEREAS, Article 99 (2) (vii) and (ix) Rule XVII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that it is within the power of the Sangguniang Panglungsod to adopt a comprehensive land use plan for the city, the formulation, adoption or modification of said plan and enact integrated zoning ordinance in consonance with the approved comprehensive land use plan, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the recommendations of the Joint Technical Review Committee of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) and the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB) adopted for the Comprehensive Land Use Plan/Zoning Ordinance of Quezon City;

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WHEREAS, to emphasize the importance of addressing two (2) significant laws namely Republic Act No. 9729, otherwise known as the Climate Change Adaptation Act and Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Act of 2010;

WHEREAS, since the time that the present Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) was approved, significant transformations have taken place in terms of the pattern, direction and intensity of change in the physical environment of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY  
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Title of the Ordinance – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as “An Ordinance Amending the Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) of 2011 to 2025”.

SECTION 2. The Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP 2011 to 2025) Ordinance No. SP-2069, S-2011 is hereby amended by the Revised Comprehensive Land Use Plan which shall be made an integral part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The City Planning and Development Office which shall ensure the strict implementation of this Ordinance, is hereby given plenary powers and authority to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinance, resolutions, executive orders and other administrative issuances found to be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly. ¶

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*SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.*




