AN ORDINANCE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING AND POWER BANK STATION AT THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPOUND, THE ENERGY SOURCE FROM ALTERNATIVE SOURCES OF ENERGY SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SOLAR ENERGY.

WHEREAS, the installation thereof in the Quezon City Hall Compound will be the first of its kind in the City which will provide needed services to existing city and barangay Electric Vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby called an Ordinance for the installation of Electric Vehicle Charging and Power Bank Station at the Quezon City hall compound, the energy source from which are alternative sources of energy, such as, but not limited to, Solar Energy.


SECTION 2. Definition of Terms:

- (a) Electric Vehicle Charging – is a process of recharging a battery;
- (b) Electric Power Bank Station – is a charging place of batteries used for Electric Vehicles including, but not limited to, the deposit, exchanges and replacement of batteries;
- (c) Electric Power Bank – is a source of electricity to recharge a battery. A



SECTION 3. Effectivity – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
