RESOLUTION NO. SP- 083, S-98

A RESOLUTION URGING ALL BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF QUEZON CITY TO CONDUCT MARATHON INFORMATION DRIVES TO MOBILIZE THEIR RESPECTIVE CONSTITUENTS TO INSTITUTE SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO MINIMIZE THE ADVERSE EFFECTS OF LA NIÑA PHENOMENON.

WHEREAS, weather experts lately gave the information that La Niña Phenomenon will replace the waning El Niño which is expected to batter the country with heavy torrential rains and strong typhoon this rainy season;

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need to institute safety and precautionary measures to avert floods that may be brought about by the massive rainfall and in order to forestall, among others, the occurrence and spread of disease/epidemic, evacuation and relief operations, loss of lives, limbs and damage to properties that may inevitably be triggered by such typhoons and floods;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to condition the minds of the Quezon City residents to prepare for the expected onslaught of La Niña in our country and to mobilize them to get involve and participate in initiating/instituting contingency measures such as but not limited to the cleaning of floating debris in esteros, digging of canals, improvement and declogging of drainage system, repairs and fortification of houses/roof tops, systematic and hygienic disposal of garbage/refuse and related activities;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all Barangay Officials of Quezon City to conduct marathon information drives to mobilize their respective constituents to institute safety and precautionary measures to minimize the adverse effect of La Niña Phenomenon.
