RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1006, 3-98

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY MAYOR MEASURES TO PREVENT AND ARREST THE SPREAD OF THE DENGUE CONTAGION IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, an ordinance was passed by the City Council of Quezon City declaring a state of calamity in the entire Quezon City and authorizing the City Mayor to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of the Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever Epidemic and allocating the necessary amount to meet this problem;

WHEREAS, the spread of the dengue contagion in Metro Manila is not only alarming but more so needs immediate measures to prevent and arrest its spread in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, it is the mandate of the City Government to protect the health and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, based on the findings of the Department of Health, the dengue disease is caused by a virus carried by the day-biting mosquito aedes aegypti which usually breeds in stagnant waters such as open canals, esteros and the like;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recommend, as it does hereby recommend, to the City Mayor the measures to prevent and arrest the spread of dengue contagion in Quezon City, to wit:

1. Immediate cleaning and fumigation of all potential breeding and contaminated places situated within Quezon City;
2. Conduct by the City Health Department and the Barangay officials, in coordination with the Department of Health of an intensive information drive in the City; and
3. The conscientious implementation by the Task Force Clean and Green, City Parks Development and Administration Department, City Engineering Office and such other agency of the Quezon City government of the clean and green program of the City government on a regular basis.
