A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND TO INTENSIFY THEIR CAMPAIGN AGAINST SELLING OF BOLD VIDEO TAPES, MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS, TABLOIDS AND SIMILAR PRINTED MATERIALS DEPICTING NAKED WOMEN AND/OR EXHIBITING OBSCENE AND INDECENT PICTURES WHICH ARE AGAINST PUBLIC MORALS AND POLICY TO THE GREAT DETRIMENT OF MINORS.

WHEREAS, publishers and editors of magazines, newspapers and tabloids nowadays, to attract readers and increase their sales, banner in its front pages, photos of naked women in total disregard of its ill-effects to children and youths;

WHEREAS, the indiscriminate display of lewd pictures including sale or rent of bold video tapes by video shops affect the volatile or fickle or unstable mind of male teeners, thus increasing aggressiveness and boldness to commit offensive and malicious act against the opposite sex;

WHEREAS, there are enough and sufficient laws enacted for this purpose, however, law enforcers, for one reason or another, remain numb, naive and reluctant or just ignore the issue and fail to apprehend, accost and charge the offender directly involved in the production, selling and distribution thereof;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Central Police District Command to intensify their campaign against selling of bold video tapes, magazines, newspapers, tabloids and similar printed materials depicting naked women and/or exhibiting obscene and indecent pictures which are against public morals and policy to the great detriment of minors.


