RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1028, S-98

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY VICE MAYOR, HONORABLE CONNIE S. ANGELES, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE COMPANY DULY LICENSED BY THE SUPERVISORY OFFICE FOR SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION AGENCY, PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE DULY ACCREDITED BY THE AWARDS COMMITTEE OF QUEZON CITY THAT WILL PROVIDE SECURITY SERVICES TO THE QUEZON CITY DRUG TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER (TAHANAN) SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (Tahanan) was created in 1990 pursuant to Ordinance No. NC-146, S-90, as a vital component of the Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Program;

WHEREAS, Tahanan is and has been under the direct operation and administration supervision and control of the Office of the City Vice-Mayor;


WHEREAS, there is a need to protect and secure the personnel, patients and properties found within the confines of Tahanan from any and all forms of adverse and criminal elements;

WHEREAS, it has become imperative to avail of the services of a private security agency that will provide appropriate security, safety and integrity for the people and property of Tahanan.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Connie S. Angeles, to enter into a contract with any reputable company duly licensed by the Supervisory Office for Security and Investigation Agency, Philippine National Police duly accredited by the Awards Committee of Quezon City, that will provide security services to the Quezon City Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (Tahanan), subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
