RESOLUTION NO. SP. 1050, S-98

A RESOLUTION HOLDING IN ABEYANCE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL'S COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM (SECOND PHASE) WITH A PROJECT COST OF EIGHT MILLION PESOS AUTHORIZED UNDER RESOLUTION NO. SP-977, SERIES OF 1998 (28 MAY 1998) AND RE-APPROPRIATING THE FUND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council's Legislative Records and Archives has undertaken its computerization and local area networking program;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the City Council's Computerization Program (First Phase) has proven its current adaptability and utility, but further improvements, though welcome, can not be considered among the priorities of the City Council's leadership and members;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the Computerization Program (Second Phase) is presently faced with technical and structural constraints, thus, to carry on with the same, would result in added costs and heightened expenses;

WHEREAS, the present economic crisis faced by the country and the residents of Quezon City has prompted the members of the Quezon City Council to hold in abeyance the implementation of its Computerization Program (Second Phase) in favor of high-impact and socially-relevant plans, programs and projects for the people of Quezon City;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to hold, as it does hereby hold, in abeyance the implementation of the Quezon City Council's Computerization Program (Second Phase) with a project cost of Eight Million Pesos authorized under Resolution No. 977, Series of 1998 (28 May 1998).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the amount appropriated for the purpose is hereby re-appropriated and treated as a continuing appropriation for Fiscal Year 1999 to undertake the Integrated Socio-Economic Amelioration Program (ISAP), the City Council's anti-poverty, livelihood and capability building program for the residents of Quezon City.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that this Resolution be furnished the Budget, Accounting, and Treasury Offices for their information and guidance.
