Resolution No. SP-10523-1998

A RESOLUTION URGING ALL OFFICIALS IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO OBSERVE DECEMBER 10 OF THIS YEAR AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER AS HUMAN RIGHTS DAY.

WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights provision in our Constitution, Article III, Section I, provides that no person shall be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law, nor any person shall be deprived of equal protection of the law;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units, as stated in the Local Government Code, shall exercise powers expressly granted to ensure and support, among other things, the promotion and protection of social justice and human rights;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City government, as the premiere city, should take measures that will abet the elimination of crimes against persons; one way of which is through the observance of a Human Rights Day, as it will expose the residents of this city to the importance and practice of human rights;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all officials in the City government to observe December 10 of this year and every year thereafter as Human Rights Day, to promote awareness in its importance and to prevent our constituents from committing acts of inhumanity.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to all city officials in Quezon City for their immediate consideration and action.
