WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the performance of the duties and services of the elected officials of Quezon City, to make them immediately identifiable by their constituents, and be more accessible to the people, the issuance of special vehicular license plates is recommended;

WHEREAS, for identification purposes, a number according to their rank will be placed;

WHEREAS, for the realization of this purpose, and in order to process the issuance of the special plates, a resolution by the City Council to this effect must be submitted to the Department of Transportation and Communication;


