RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1076 S-1999

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING ALL THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY TWO (142) SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO ENACT A BARANGAY REVENUE ORDINANCE TO AUGMENT THEIR RESOURCES OR FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the only primary sources of funds of the barangays are their share on Real Property Tax Collection and Internal Revenue Allotment unless there are city aids, grants and subsidies and also depending on the receipts to support its operations including programs and projects intended for their constituents;

WHEREAS, Sec.129 of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, specifically provides that:

Sec. 129. Power to Create Sources of Revenue- Each local government units shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and levy fees and charges, subject to the provisions herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes, fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the local government units.

WHEREAS, there is a need to augment the resources and funds of the barangay by passing, approving and enacting a Barangay Revenue Ordinance consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy, existing laws and city ordinance, to be able to realize the program and projects provided under its barangay development plan;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, all the One
