Resolution No. SP-1091 S-1999

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO PRESCRIBE A UNIFORM AND CORRECT PROTOCOL IN EVERY OFFICIAL ACTIVITY OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT BY MAKING THE OPENING PRAYER AS THE FIRST PART OF EVERY CITY PROGRAM AND CITY COUNCIL'S SESSION.

WHEREAS, in every official function or activity of the City government such as meetings, sessions, conferences, seminars and other forms of gatherings and celebrations there is no prescribed standard or uniform protocol that is being observed;

WHEREAS, it has been noted, for example, that the order of business in most official functions and activities has the singing of the Philippine National Anthem before the opening prayer while in some, the prayer comes ahead of the National Anthem;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the City government to prescribe a uniform and correct protocol in every official activity of the city government by making the opening prayer as the first part of every City program and City Council's session.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Cultural and Tourism Affairs Office be tasked with making a uniform and correct protocol manual.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Office of the City Mayor for their information and appropriate action.
