RESOLUTION NO. SP-T 115, S-99

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) THAT TRAFFIC ENFORCERS TO BE DEPLOYED/ASSIGNED IN QUEZON CITY SHOULD BE RESIDENTS OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 5 (e) of Republic Act No. 7924, provides:

“xxx The MMDA shall set the policies concerning traffic in Metro Manila, and shall coordinate and regulate the implementation of all programs and projects concerning traffic management specially pertaining to enforcement, engineering and education. Upon request, it shall extend assistance and cooperation including, but not limited to, assignment of personnel, by all other government agencies and officers concerned. xxx”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the foregoing provision of the law, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) deployed/assigned in major thoroughfares of Quezon City, Traffic Enforcers to regulate traffic flows within the said area;

WHEREAS, the traffic enforcers assigned/deployed in Quezon City are not, or most often than not, residents of Quezon City,

WHEREAS, it has been observed oftentimes that traffic enforcers assigned/deployed in Quezon City do not recognize the authority of the City's elected officials, hence, they appear discourteous, unrespectful and worst, causing delay in attending to their official functions;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Chairman of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) that traffic enforcers to be deployed/assigned in Quezon City should be residents of Quezon City,


