A RESOLUTION URGING THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO ADOPT A NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME AND TO COORDINATE WITH THE AFFECTED BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO MEET THE INCREASED TRAFFIC VOLUME CAUSED BY THE ONGOING CONSTRUCTION OF MRT 2 AND MRT 3 SYSTEM ALONG AURORA BOULEVARD AND EPIFANIO DELOS SANTOS AVENUE (EDSA).

WHEREAS, Barangay E. Rodriguez, Sr. passed Council Resolution No. 44, S-98 entitled "A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE ADOPTION OF A NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME TO MEET THE INCREASED TRAFFIC VOLUME CAUSED BY THE ONGOING CONSTRUCTION OF THE LRT 2 AND LRT 3 SYSTEMS";

WHEREAS, component barangays covering the stretch of Aurora, Blvd., including Barangay E. Rodriguez, are greatly affected by said project resulting in the increased volume of vehicles within Barangay streets which serve as alternate routes;


WHEREAS, as a result of this increase, traffic conditions within the aforementioned areas are adversely affected;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the city government along with the agency concerned should provide remedial measures that will alleviate the worsening traffic condition in the areas concerned as a result of the ongoing MRT 2 and MRT 3 projects.


NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority to adopt a new traffic scheme and to coordinate with the affected barangays in Quezon City to meet the increased traffic volume caused by the ongoing construction of MRT 2 and MRT 3 system along Aurora Boulevard and Epifanio Delos Santos Avenue (EDSA).
