A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO) FOR LAUNCHING THE "BOTIKA NG MASA" PROJECT, AND EXPRESSING THE CITY GOVERNMENT'S APPRECIATION TO SAID AGENCY FOR ESTABLISHING THE SAID "BOTIKA NG MASA" IN HOSPITALS OPERATING IN QUEZON CITY AND URGING FURTHER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SAME IN THE BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY.

NOW, THEREFORE,


