A RESOLUTION URGING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC) TO INTENSIFY ITS CAMPAIGN AND STRICTLY ENFORCE ALL EXISTING LAWS AGAINST THE OPERATION OF VIDEO KARERA MACHINES IN QUEZON CITY.

"x x x Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of the culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balance ecology, encourage and support the development of the appropriate and self reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."
