A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT CENTER (SDC), SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, as provided for in Section 17 (a) of R.A. 7160, local government units shall exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, sub-section (b) 2 (iv) of Section 17, supra, likewise provides that basic services and facilities include social welfare services including programs and projects on child and youth welfare and nutrition services;

WHEREAS, PHI 5478 project, more particularly known as the "Street Children Nutrition and Educational Project" is now being implemented in thirteen (13) local government units of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government, by virtue of its mandate, which is to enhance the capability of local government units in the delivery of such basic service to their constituencies, has been designated as the executing agency for the above-mentioned project;

WHEREAS, Quezon City, having been identified as one of those with considerable number of street children, has been selected as one of the implementors of the project due to its capacity to carry out and sustain a similar project in the future;

WHEREAS, under revised PHI 5478 Plan of Operation, one of the output of the project is the construction and maintenance of a Social Development Center (SDC) in Quezon City to support the City's social growth and development program;


WHEREAS, a counterpart funding from the City government of at least 25% of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P3.5 M.) allocated for the project is thereby required for the construction and maintenance of the SDC building;

WHEREAS, the SDC shall serve as multi-purpose training center for social workers, project volunteers and beneficiaries, processing and drop-in center for street children, meeting, assemblies and other project related activities and the City's other social services clientele;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Hon. Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) for the construction and maintenance of a Social Development Center (SDC), subject to ratification by the City Council.
