RESOLUTION NO. SP-1174 3 S-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE BARANGAY SECURITY AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICER (BSDO) MARCELINO CORPUZ OF BARANGAY TEACHERS' VILLAGE WEST, DILIMAN, QUEZON CITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE 1999 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the medical and funeral expenses incurred due to the untimely death of Mr. Corpuz has brought financial difficulties to his family;

WHEREAS, in recognition to the invaluable contribution of Marcelino Corpuz in the preservation of peace and order and public safety, it is appropriate for the City government to grant financial assistance to his family as a manifestation of appreciation to the heroic deed of Mr. Corpuz while performing his official duties as Barangay Security and Development Officer of Barangay Teachers Village West;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the bereaved family of the late Barangay Security Development Officer (BSDO) Marcelino Corpuz of Barangay Teachers Village West, Diliman, Quezon City, in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to be charged against the appropriation for Grants, Subsidies and Contributions in the 1999 Annual Budget of the City Mayor's Office or from any available funds in the City Treasury.
