RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-1176~~ -S-99

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT TRAFFIC DIVISION AND OTHER AGENCIES CONCERNED TO ALLOW THE MEMBERS OF THE SAN ANTONIO PARKWAY VILLAGE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (SAPVTODA) TO TRAVERSE THROUGH ROOSEVELT AVENUE NEAR THE BANK OF PHILIPPINE ISLANDS BRANCH OFFICE AND MANGGA STREET AS LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONE FOR TRICYCLES.

WHEREAS, due to the inadequacy of transportation services along Roosevelt Avenue, commuters and the general public who are passing daily through the said street are experiencing difficulties in going to their destination;

WHEREAS, due to the urgent need to institute solutions so as to ease the transportation problems in Barangay San Antonio and Barangay Apolonio Samson, San Antonio Parkway Village Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (SAPVTODA) was formed;

WHEREAS, the members of the SAPVTODA who have been traversing through Roosevelt Avenue for almost seventeen (17) years are being apprehended by the members of the traffic group to the disadvantage of the members and specially the commuters;

WHEREAS, there are some Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (TODA) who are being allowed to load and unload along the National Road like Seminary Congressional TODA without being apprehended for doing so;

WHEREAS, the Traffic Operation Center of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority is the government agency empowered to promulgate and impose traffic rules and regulations.


NOW, THEREFORE,

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Central Police District Traffic Division shall submit the recommendation within thirty (30) days from the approval of this resolution.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copy of this resolution be furnished the Central Police District Traffic Division, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, the Department of Public Order and Safety and the Land Transportation Office.
