A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CREATION OF THE QUEZON CITY COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL PURSUANT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 93-006 SERIES OF 1993 OF THE COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article X11 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The Congress shall create an agency to promote the viability and growth of cooperative as instrument for social justice and economic development";

WHEREAS, Article 2 of Republic Act No. 6938, otherwise known as the Cooperative Code of the Philippines provides that, "It is the declared policy of the State to foster the creation and growth of cooperative as a practical vehicle for promoting self-reliance and harnessing people power towards the attainment of economic development and social justice";

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State, under Section 2 of Executive Order No. 96, that "The local government unit shall contribute to the development of cooperatives in their respective area in accordance with the State policies on cooperatives prescribed in R.A. No. 6938 and R.A. No. 6939, and such cooperative shall be coordinated by the Cooperative Development Authority";

WHEREAS, Cooperative Development Authority Memorandum Circular No. 93-006 Series of 1993, reiterates that "The establishment of Cooperative Development Council is authorized under Executive Order No. 95, Series of 1993 at the city levels". Such Councils are also impliedly authorized under Article 2 of the Cooperative Code which state that "The State shall encourage the private sector to undertake the actual formation and organization of cooperatives, and shall create an environment that is conducive to the growth and development of their cooperatives";

WHEREAS, other neighboring cities and municipalities have already formed their respective Cooperative Development Councils and are presently working hand-in-hand with the local government units in the promotion and advancement of cooperativism in their respective localities;


WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Committee on Cooperatives of the Sangguniang Panlungsod for the past three (3) years, has adhered to the laws on cooperative, helped organize cooperatives in the community, took part in the promotion and advancement of cooperatives in the City, and even extended technical, as well, as personal assistance to their projects and programs;

WHEREAS, in a meeting held last August 21, 1997 at the Office of the Chairman of the Committee on Cooperatives, City Council, Quezon City, attended by several representatives from the different registered cooperatives operating within Quezon City and other concerned government agencies involved in cooperative development have organized the Quezon City Cooperative Development Council and elected its officers.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recognize, as it does hereby recognize, the creation of the Quezon City Cooperative Development Council pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 93-006, Series of 1993 of the Cooperative Development Authority.
