RESOLUTION NO. SP-1182, S-99

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING A POSTHUMOUS COMMENDATION TO THE LATE PO1 RICHARD CABATAC OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT (CPD), STATION 11, FOR HIS INCOMPARABLE BRAVERY AND GALLANTRY, WHO DIED WHILE HE AND THE OTHER POLICE OPERATIVES WAS CONFRONTING A GROUP OF ROBBERS AT BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, GALAS, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, PO1 Richard Cabatac, a member of the Quezon City Police Force, who was assigned at Central Police District (CPD), Station 11, together with six (6) other CPD operatives, responded to an alert call of an ongoing robbery at R.L. Jordan Grocery in San Isidro, Galas, District IV, Quezon City.

WHEREAS, in the course of the operation, PO1 Richard Cabatac, apparently in a bid to immediately get the suspects, walked toward one of them, but he was met by balls of fire hitting him on the chest and left knee;

WHEREAS, to die while responding to a call of duty should be considered a heroic act because rarely we can find nowadays, person/s who would risk his life and the future of his family in adherence to his pledge of commitment as a police officer;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, a posthumous commendation to the late PO1 Richard Cabatac of the Central Police District (CPD), Station 11, for his incomparable bravery and gallantry, who died while he and the other police operatives was confronting a group of robbers at Barangay San Isidro Galas, District IV, Quezon City.


