RESOLUTION NO. SP-1186-, S-99

A RESOLUTION URGING HIS HONOR, MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., TO DIRECT THE CITY ENGINEER'S OFFICE TO IMMEDIATELY CONDUCT A SURVEY ON THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARY BETWEEN. QUEZON CITY AND MARIKINA CITY, IN COORDINATION WITH THE BUREAU OF LANDS AND SURVEYS AND TO PROPERLY MARK THE SAME ON THE GROUND.

WHEREAS, the right to shelter is a basic right enshrined in the constitution and as such, it must be protected from anyone who seeks to destroy the inviolability of the home:

WHEREAS, the demolition of several houses in Kaingin II, Barangay Pansol, Quezon City last March 4, 1999 by the Marikina City government is an act of wanton disregard of Quezon City's territorial boundary and basic human rights of the residents;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the proper delineation and markings of the territorial boundary between Quezon City and Marikina City to avoid future conflicts and disputes;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, His Honor, Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., to direct the City Engineer's Office to immediately conduct a survey on the territorial boundary between Quezon City and Marikina City, in coordination with the Bureau of Lands and Surveys and to properly mark the same on the ground.
