RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-1104-~~ 9-99

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT GROUP OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) TO ASSIGN FOUR (4) MOBILE TEAMS TO PATROL FROM 10:00 P.M. TO 6:00 A.M., THE STRETCH OF KATIPUNAN AVENUE, ALL THE WAY TO WHITE PLAINS AVENUE, INCLUDING E. RODRIQUEZ AVENUE, NEAR LIBIS, TO DETER SPECIFICALLY ILLEGAL CAR RACING, RECKLESS AND/OR DRUNK DRIVING ALONG THE AFORECTED THOROUGHFARES.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7924 which took effect on June 20, 1995, creating the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), provides that the MMDA shall set the policies concerning traffic in Metro Manila, and shall coordinate and regulate the implementation of all programs and projects concerning traffic management, specifically pertaining to enforcement, engineering and education";

WHEREAS, His Honor the City Mayor of Quezon City is one of the members of the Metropolitan Manila His Council, the governing board and policy making body of the MMDA;

WHEREAS, car racing, reckless and/or drunk driving are the major causes of vehicular collision as well as fatal accidents in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the favorite stretch of road used by car racers, speedsters, reckless and/or drunk drivers is that from the beginning of White Plains Avenue on EDSA all the way to Katipunan Avenue until a little past Ateneo University, as well as on E. Rodriguez Avenue, near Libis;

WHEREAS, in order to minimize, if not totally stop, the incidence of car racing, reckless and/or drunk driving along the City's major thoroughfares, the assignment on a twenty-four (24) hour basis of at least two mobile teams to patrol the aforementioned would be a big deterrent factor for would-be traffic offenders and/or violators;

Rodriguez Avenue, near Libis, to deter specifically illegal car racing, reckless and/or drunk driving along the aforementioned thoroughfares.
