A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY OF MARIKINA TO FACILITATE THE RELOCATION OF THEIR ROAD BOUNDARY SIGNS PLACED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BARANGAY PANSOL, QUEZON CITY TO THE PRECISE LOCATION AS SPECIFIED IN THE NATIONAL MAPPING AND RESOURCE INFORMATION AUTHORITY (NAMRIA).

WHEREAS, the authorities of the City of Marikina have placed their road boundary signs approximately five hundred (500) meters within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Pansol, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, based on the report and the map of National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA) submitted by the Office of the City Engineer of Quezon City, it is shown that the area wherein the road boundary signs of Marikina City are placed are indeed found within the territorial boundaries of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there have been further reports that certain authorities of the City of Marikina recently demolished a house and attempted to demolish several others in Barangay Pansol, the owners and occupants thereof are residents and registered voters of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, it was also learned that the concerned authorities of Marikina City and some barangay officials, BSDO's and residents of Barangay Pansol, Quezon City have almost come to a confrontation and nearly clashed with each other;

WHEREAS, likewise, there have been reports by Pansol barangay officials and residents of several incidents in the past involving confrontations and near clashes between Barangay Pansol residents and officials and the Marikina City authorities;

WHEREAS, there is a reported tension in the said area and to avoid future untoward and potentially violent incidents between the authorities of Marikina City and the barangay officials and residents of Quezon City, there is an urgent need for the City Council of Quezon City to address the aforesaid problem;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the City of Marikina to facilitate the relocation of their road boundary signs placed within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Pansol, Quezon City, to the precise location as specified in the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to the City Mayor of Marikina City and the City Mayor of Quezon City for their information and guidance.
