RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-1215~~ SP-1215 S-99

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR. TO ESTABLISH A GIRLS TOWN TO SERVE AS REHABILITATION CENTER FOR FEMALE YOUTH OFFENDERS, SEXUALLY ABUSED VICTIMS AND OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTHS TO MAKE THEM PRODUCTIVE CITIZENS.

Introduced by Councilor WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Elizabeth A. Delarmente, Ma. Fresca M. Biglang-awa, Jorge L. Banal, Nanette Castelo Daza and Alma F. Montilla.

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the 1987 Constitution, specifically provides, that:

“Sec. 13. The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral and spiritual, intellectual and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs.”

WHEREAS, the incidence of rape and sexually abused victims aggravated by numerous cases of youth offenders involving teenage girls resulting from the use of illegal drugs and, may be, due to poverty is quite alarming which the national government, in coordination with the local government units, should address with concrete and definite action;

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a Girls Town to serve as rehabilitation center for all female youth offenders, sexually abused teenagers, and out-of-school youths of the country, and bring them back to the society fully recovered from the sad and traumatic experience, thus, leading them to live a modest life;


NOW, THEREFORE,


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Philippine Senate and the House of the Representatives, for information and appropriate action.
