A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DISTRICT DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND, P/SR SUPT. ROMULO SALES, P/SUPT. FRANCISCO OVILLA, P/SR INSP. EDWIN J. MISADOR, SPO4 JESUS M. PATRIARCA, SPO3 BENJAMIN FONACIER, SPO1 MANUEL T. MALONG AND SPO1 RONNIE E. BODAJE, OF STATION 9, CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND, FOR THEIR BRAVERY, DEDICATION TO DUTY, PERSEVERANCE IN BRINGING TO AN END THE INGLORIOUS CAREER OF RAFAEL NAZARETA, QUEZON CITY'S PUBLIC ENEMY NO.1 AND BRINGING PEACE AND ORDER TO QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1999, RAFAEL NAZARETA, after a court hearing at the Quezon City Hall of Justice, was able to disarm his escort and drove away on a van owned by the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology;

WHEREAS, Police Station 9, through the Station Intelligence and Investigation Branch issued an alarm of the detainee's escape;

WHEREAS, Station 9 received information that RAFAEL NAZARETA, is a notorious carnapper and rapist, who disguised as a legitimate taxi driver, divest his passengers, usual pretty females, of their jewelry and then sexual molest them when the opportunity present itself;

WHEREAS, long before his escape, RAFAEL NAZARETA was already wanted for a series of robbery-holdup;

WHEREAS, acting on information that RAFAEL NAZARETA was at Barangay Botocan, Quezon City on May 18, 1999, the members of the Central Police District Command, Station 9, Supt. Ovilla and his men composed of P/Sr. Insp. EDWIN J. MISADOR, SPO4 JESUS M. PATRIARCA, SPO3 BENJAMIN FONACIER, SPO1 MANUEL MALONG and SPO1 RONNIE BODAJE intensified their campaign to apprehend the No.1 menace to society;

WHEREAS, while on patrol, the group sighted a parked taxicab along Pajo and Chico Streets in Quirino District and upon approaching the stalled taxicab the driver drew a gun and fired at the lawmen then sped towards Xavierville where the culprit engaged with the lawmen in a running gun battle thereby killing NAZARETA;

WHEREAS, due to the dedication of duty of P/SUPT. FRANCISCO OVILLA and his men, particularly P/SR. INSP. EDWIN J. MISADOR, SPO4 JESUS M. PATRICIA, SPO3 BENJAMIN A. FONACIER, SPO1 MANUEL T. MALONG and SPO1 RONNIE BODAJE, the criminal career of Quezon City Public Enemy No. 1 has come to a fitting end;

WHEREAS, earlier P/SUPT. OVILLA had launched a campaign against criminality pursuant to MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR. directive to restore peace and order by ridding the City of criminal elements;


WHEREAS, P/SUPT. OVILLA had been cited by Mayor Mathay for his BRAVERY, DEVOTION TO DUTY, AND PERSEVERANCE maintaining peace and security of Quezon City families under his jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, were it not for the bravery, tenacity, devotion to duty and a keen sense of justice of these heroes and dedicated officers and men, RAFAEL NAZARETA would have been still free today continuing his evil deeds;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to commend, as it does hereby commend, The District Director of the Central Police District Command, P/SR Supt. ROMULO SALES, and P/SUPT. FRANCISCO OVILLA, P/SR INSP. EDWIN J. MISADOR, SPO4 JESUS M. PATRIARCA, SPO3 BENJAMIN FONACIER, SPO1 MANUEL T. MALONG and SPO1 RONNIE E. BODAJE, of Station 9, Central Police District Command, for their bravery, dedication to duty, perseverance in bringing to an end the inglorious career of RAFAEL NAZARETA, Quezon City's Public Enemy No.1 and bringing peace and order to Quezon City.
