RESOLUTION NO. SP-1222, S-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE SPO2 CARLITO U. SEMILLA, A MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC), IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, SPO2 Carlito U. Semilla, a member of the Central Police District Command, who died last January 19, 1999 of Chronic Renal Failure leading to cardiac arrest, had faithfully served the City as a police officer for over 22 years;


WHEREAS, during his long service to the people of Quezon City, SPO2 Semilla displayed the endearing virtues of a dedicated peace officer;

WHEREAS, it is only but fitting and proper that the City, in behalf of grateful people, extend to the bereaved family of the late SPO2 Carlito U. Semilla a financial assistance to enable them to start a new life without their breadwinner;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the bereaved family of the late SPO2 Carlito U. Semilla, a member of the Central Police District Command (CPDC), in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) chargeable against the appropriation for grants, subsidies and contributions in the annual budget of the office of the City Mayor or from any available funds in the City Treasury for the purpose.
