RESOLUTION NO. SP- 4229 S-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE PO3 MARIO TUPAZ NICOMEDEZ, FORMER MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND, PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, OR FROM ANY FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, PO3 Mario T. Nicomedez entered the government service as Fireman on May 16, 1988 and transferred to the PNP with the rank of Police Officer III and assigned to the Central Police District Command at the Office of the Deputy District Director for Operation from January 2, 1991 until his untimely demise on January 24, 1998;

WHEREAS, the untimely demise of PO3 Nicomedez placed his family in an emotional as well as financial difficulties having no other member of the family who has sufficient means of livelihood to sustain their daily living and the educational expenses of his family;

WHEREAS, almost all the life savings of PO3 Mario T. Nicomedez have gone to the medical and funeral services and his family now faces a bleak future;

WHEREAS, in the light of the foregoing and in deference to the service he has so far unselfishly and selflessly dedicated to the public, PO3 Mario T. Nicomedez deserves to be extended financial assistance to lighten the burden of his bereaved family occasioned by his untimely death;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Memorandum Circular No. 1 Series of 1995 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-154, S-94, member of the Central Police District Command who die or suffer from total and permanent disability, incapacity in line of duty, regardless of police service are entitled to financial assistance in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00);

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to the family of the late PO3 Mario T. Nicomedez, former member of the Central Police District Command, Philippine National Police, the amount to be charged against the appropriation for grants, subsidies and contributions in the 1999 Annual Budget of the Office of the City Mayor or from any available funds for the purpose.
