RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-1230~~, S-99

A RESOLUTION URGING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN QUEZON CITY TO DISPLAY THE SIGN "THIS ESTABLISHMENT IS SENIOR CITIZEN FRIENDLY" AT A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN THEIR RESPECTIVE ESTABLISHMENTS.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7432, otherwise known as the Senior Citizen Law, requires that all establishments catering to citizens sixty (60) years old and above extend twenty percent (20%) discount;

WHEREAS, the present economic situation of the country has made it a necessity for all establishments to extend the necessary assistance through the required discounts to ease the burden of expenses of the retirees;

WHEREAS, there have been reports and complaints that some establishments in Quezon City do not honor the requirement as provided for in the Senior Citizen Law;

WHEREAS, in order to avoid confusion and misunderstanding between senior citizen patrons and management owners, operators and workers, it is, therefore, deemed proper for establishments to post a notice in any conspicuous place in their respective areas of operation to be identified as a senior citizen friendly institution.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all business establishments in Quezon City to display the sign "THIS ESTABLISHMENT IS SENIOR CITIZEN FRIENDLY" at a conspicuous place in their respective establishments.
