A RESOLUTION DECLARING AUGUST 23-28, 1999 AS QUEZON CITY CHAMBERETTE WEEK.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Chamberette, Inc., and the Quezon City Chamberette Foundation, Inc., are twin organizations involved, since 1962, in projects and activities for the benefit of the less fortunate, the destitute and those who have less in life;

WHEREAS, these two (2) non-governmental organizations have constructed five (5) multi-purpose centers in Quezon City located at Kalayaan B, Freedom Park, and barangays Imelda, Loyola, and Payatas that serve as venues of Day-Care Programs;

WHEREAS, these organizations subsidize the monthly salaries of day-care teachers in the aforesaid centers while the Quezon City government provides food for the pre-school students enrolled therein;

WHEREAS, annually, these organizations undertake Christmas Cheers Operations by giving gift packages to our less fortunate children, such as toys and bedroom needs for the abandoned infants and kids, new pairs of shoes, and food for the aged;

WHEREAS, other services are also provided for by the said organizations consisting of medical, dental and other health programs, such as free circumcision, x-ray, and sputum test for determination of tuberculosis, livelihood projects, vocational courses and other programs against drug addiction and indecent shows;

WHEREAS, workshop seminars on speech and grammar improvement during summer are also undertaken by the said organizations for all the day-care teachers employed by the Quezon City government;


WHEREAS, a school building was likewise constructed by the said organizations which was donated to the National Center for Mental Health;

WHEREAS, in 1973, during the incumbency of Honorable Mayor Norberto Amoranto, the said organizations have conferred loyalty and service awards to the Quezon City government employees with at least twenty (20) years of service;
