A RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE DISTRICT DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC) TO DIRECT ALL INVESTIGATING POLICEMEN ASSIGNED IN EVERY POLICE STATION IN QUEZON CITY TO TURN OVER THE INVESTIGATION/POLICE REPORTS AND OTHER SIMILAR DOCUMENTS IN THEIR POSSESSION/CUSTODY TO THEIR SUBSTITUTE POLICE OFFICER/INVESTIGATOR WHO SHALL TAKE OVER THEIR POST OR THE NEXT SHIFT BEFORE LEAVING THE OFFICE OR BEFORE THEY TAKE THEIR OFF-DUTY.

WHEREAS, crimes usually occur during nighttime and the circumstance surrounding thereon are taken by police officer or investigator on duty;

WHEREAS, it has been the practice of some police investigators who prepared the investigation/police reports to keep the same in their possession/custody when leaving from office or while they are off duty, making the substitute investigation policeman absolutely unaware of what transpired prior to their reporting to office and of the records of the case;

WHEREAS, parties to a crime, vehicular accidents and similar incidents which occurred during night time have to wait until the investigating policeman reports back to office for them to be able to secure a copy of the said investigation/police reports, to their great inconvenience and prejudice;

WHEREAS, such unreasonable delay in the production/preparation of investigation/police reports does not only result to the snail's pace prosecution of criminal cases, but sometimes become the source of graft and corruption for there are unscrupulous policemen who ask grease money from the parties concerned so that they can easily secure the needed investigation/police report;


WHEREAS, to discourage and prevent this irregularity, the District Director of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) shall direct all investigating policemen assigned in every police station in Quezon City to turn over the investigation/police reports and similar documents in their possession/custody to their substitute police officer/investigator before leaving the office or before they take their off-duty;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to enjoin, as it does hereby enjoin, the District Director of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) to direct all investigating policemen assigned in every police station in Quezon City to turn over the investigation/police reports and other similar documents in their possession/custody to their substitute police officer/investigator who shall take over their post or the next shift before leaving the office or before they take their off-duty.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be immediately forwarded to the Office of the District Director, Central Police District Command (CPDC), for his information and appropriate action.
