RESOLUTION NO. SP-1266, S-99

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A QUEZON CITY-WIDE INFORMATION DISSEMINATION CAMPAIGN ON THE REFERENDUM TO RATIFY THE CREATION OF NOVALICHES CITY.

Introduced by Councilors JORGE L. BANAL, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, GEORGE M. CANSECO, GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA and NANETTE CASTELO DAZA.

WHEREAS, the Commission on Elections in its Resolution No. 3085 has set on October 23, 1999 the City-wide referendum to ratify R.A. 8535, an act creating the City of Novaliches;

WHEREAS, the question of whether to approve or not the separation of Novaliches from Quezon City will have a significant impact and wide-ranging implications on Quezon City and its residents;

WHEREAS, on the whole, the reasons for and against the ratification on R.A. 8535 have not been adequately and effectively disseminated to the residents of the City particularly those in the 1st, 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> districts;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to call, as it does hereby call, on all concerned city government agencies and instrumentalities concerned to have an intensified Quezon City-wide information campaign on the Referendum to ratify R.A. 8535 creating the City of Novaliches scheduled by the Commission on Elections on October 23, 1999.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to urge the Quezon City Public Affairs and Information Service Office (PAISO), the Quezon City Barangay Operations Center (BOC), and the Public Information Agency (PIA) to lead the information dissemination campaign.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the following be provided copies of this Resolution: the Quezon City Public Affairs Information Service Office, the Quezon City Barangay Operations Center, Public Information Agency and all news organizations in Quezon City.
