RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1269, S-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SPO2 ANTONIO BERROYA, A MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC), FORMERLY ASSIGNED AT THE MOLAVE YOUTH HOME, CITY HALL COMPOUND, AND LATER TO CAMP KARINGAL DSWD, BOTH IN QUEZON CITY, WHOSE LEFT FOOT WAS AMPUTATED DUE TO SEVERE AILMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (P12,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999.

Introduced by Councilors ERIC Z. MEDINA and ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS.

WHEREAS, SPO2 Antonio Berroya is a member of the Central Police District Command (CPDC), who rendered unselfish, honest and loyal service to Quezon City for almost twenty-five (25) years;

WHEREAS, while in the performance of his official duty, SPO2 Berroya suffered severe ailment which resulted to the amputation of his left foot;

WHEREAS, such unfortunate incident which made his family financially distressed prompted him to write to His Honor, Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., to ask for financial assistance which the latter, through his marginal note, approved the amount of Twelve Thousand Pesos (P12,000.00), a copy of said letter is attached and forms part of this resolution;

WHEREAS, as a gesture of support, it is appropriate for the City government to extend financial assistance to SPO2 Berroya for his dedicated service in the preservation of peace and order in Quezon City;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to SPO2 Antonio Berroya, a member of the Central Police District Command (CPDC), formerly assigned at the Molave Youth Home, City Hall Compound, and later to Camp Karingal DSWD, both in Quezon City, whose left foot was amputated due to severe ailment, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Pesos (P12,000.00) to be taken from the appropriations for grants, subsidies and contributions under the Office of the City Mayor in the City's Annual Budget for fiscal year 1999.
