RESOLUTION NO SP- 1279 , S-99

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE LOCAL FILM INDUSTRY THRU THE INCENTIVE PROGRAM OF THE FILM DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC. (FDFPD), BY WAY OF ONE HUNDRED (100) PERCENT AMUSEMENT TAX REBATES FOR FIFTEEN (15) QUALITY FILMS TO BE RATED BY THE FILM RATINGS BOARD (FRB) FROM OCTOBER 1, 1999 TO DECEMBER 31, 1999.

WHEREAS, R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, "local government units (LGUs) shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture and arts";

WHEREAS, His Excellency, President Joseph Ejercito Estrada, issued on March 29, 1999, a memorandum directing the DILG Undersecretary (now Secretary) Ronaldo V. Puno to assist the Film Development Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. (FDFPI) and the Film Ratings Board (FRB) in soliciting the assistance and support of local government units through the local government leagues and the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority by way of granting amusement tax rebates to quality local films rated by FRB;

WHEREAS, the FDFPI's incentive program encourages producers and film directors to make quality films that would be acceptable and competitive in the local and international markets;

WHEREAS, granting of amusement tax rebates to fifteen (15) local quality films for the period July 1, 1999 to December 31, 1999 will not really hurt the city government as this incentive is expected to generate increase in the production output of film makers thereby making up in the loss of government revenues.


