RESOLUTION NO. SP- 4292 , S-99

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) TO INSTALL A TRAFFIC LIGHT AND OTHER PRECAUTIONARY AND SAFETY DEVICES ALONG BALOY STREET AND G. ARANETA AVENUE, FRONTING SO-EN GARMENTS FACTORY, SO AS TO MINIMIZE AND PREVENT LOSS OF LIVES AND LIMBS AMONG THE RESIDENTS OF SURROUNDING BARANGAYS ARISING FROM VEHICULAR ACCIDENTS.

WHEREAS, police power is conferred upon local government units (LGU) under Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, which provides for the General Welfare Clause, to wit: "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers xxx, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants therein,"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Santol, Fourth District, Quezon City, has enacted Barangay Resolution No. 20, Series of 1999, urging the proper authorities to install the traffic light and other safety devices along Baloy Street and G. Araneta Avenue, in front of the So-en Garments Factory to protect residents, as well as motorists from the risks of vehicular accidents;

WHEREAS, there is a great urgency for the installation of a traffic light and other precautionary and safety devices in the area on account of the alarming rise in the incidence of vehicular accidents in the vicinity;

WHEREAS, the immediate passage of this measure will enable the city government of Quezon City to protect its residents from the risks of meeting untoward vehicular accidents;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) to install traffic light and other precautionary and
