WHEREAS, children around the world are victims of poverty, dislocation and abusive social structures;

WHEREAS, in the Philippines alone, more than 18.6 Million Filipino children live in poverty, 1.4 Million are victims of child labor and 1.2 Million roam the streets while countless others are victims of various form of exploitation;

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the Constitution states that:

"... The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well being..."

WHEREAS, the Universal Declaration of the Rights of the Child proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly, of which the Philippines is a member, declares that: "The child shall enjoy special protection, and shall be given opportunities and facilities by law and by other means to enable him to develop physically, mentally, morally, spiritually and socially in a healthy and normal manner and in a condition of freedom and dignity;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that Quezon City, as the biggest city of the metropolis should take the lead in this campaign;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to direct the City Secretary to disseminate this Resolution as widely and extensively as possible.
