RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP~~ 4296, S-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE (27) FAMILIES WHO WERE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED IN THE EARLY MORNING OF FEBRUARY 17, 1999 IN STA. BARBARA STREET, BGY. GULOD, NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY SIX THOUSAND PESOS (P36,000.00) FOR THE EIGHTEEN (18) FAMILY HOMEOWNERS AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY HOMEOWNER, AND NINE THOUSAND PESOS (P9,000.00) FOR THE NINE (9) FAMILY-RENTERS/SHARERS AT ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000) PER FAMILY-RENTER/SHARER, AMOUNTING TO A TOTAL OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P45,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE BUDGET FOR CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUNDS OF THE CITY MAYOR UNDER GRANTS, AIDS AND SUBSIDIES FOR THE YEAR 1999.

WHEREAS, a fire occurred in the early morning of February 16, 1999 in Sta. Barbara St., Bgy. Gulod, Novaliches, Quezon City, and rendered twenty-seven (27) families homeless, as per initial report of the Social Welfare and Development Department, eighteen (18) of whom were family-homeowners and nine (9) were family-renters/sharers;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (I) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly provides, thus:

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 26 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate power of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said event;"

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City government to extend assistance in any form to the above mentioned fire victims who are constituents of the city to cushion the impact of this unforeseen event;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the twenty-seven (27) families who were victims of the fire that occurred in the early morning of February 17, 1999, in Sta. Barbara Street, Bgy. Galod, Novales, Quezon City, in the amount of Thirty Six Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) for the eighteen (18) family homeowners at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family homeowner, and Nine Thousand Pesos (P9,000.00) for the 9 family renters/sharers at One Thousand Pesos (P1,000) per family-renter/sharer, amounting to a total of Forty Five Thousand Pesos (P45,000) to be taken from the budget for Calamity or Emergency Funds of the City Mayor under Grants, Aids and Subsidies for the year 1999
