A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC) AND THE FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES DIVISION, PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE IN CAMP CRAME, TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE POLICY GUIDELINES OF DEPOSITING SERVICE FIREARMS ISSUED TO POLICE AND MILITARY OFFICERS OR CIVILIANS ISSUED A PERMIT TO CARRY FIREARM WHEN THEY ENTER GOVERNMENT OFFICES, COURTROOMS, COCKTAIL LOUNGES, BARS, RESTAURANTS, NIGHTCLUBS AND OTHER SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS WHEN NOT IN OFFICIAL MISSION OR WHEN THE CARRYING OF SAID FIREARM IS NOT NECESSARY INSIDE SAID PREMISES.

WHEREAS, it has been observed and noted that members of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) or civilians issued a permit to carry firearm transacting or following official transactions with any government agency or attending administrative or judicial hearing, or entering cocktail lounges, bars, night clubs, restaurants and similar establishments deliberately fail and refuse to deposit their service firearms or firearm in their possession;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the policy guidelines formulated by the Philippine National Police (PNP) members of the PNP or civilians are enjoined to deposit their service firearm or firearms in their possession to the proper personnel everytime they enter government offices, courtrooms, cocktail lounges, bars, nightclubs, restaurants and similar establishments;

WHEREAS, the utter disregard to comply with the said policy guidelines by some members of the Command and civilians possessing firearms, is a clear indication that their superiors or the Command or the Firearms and Explosives Division are lax and remiss in the implementation of the same as well as in reminding civilians licensed to carry firearms to comply with the policy guidelines;




NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Central Police District Command (CPDC) and the Firearms and Explosives Division, Philippine National Police in Camp Crame, to strictly implement the policy guidelines of depositing service firearms issued to police and military officers or civilians issued a permit to carry firearm when they enter government offices, court rooms, cocktail lounges, bars, restaurants, nightclubs and other similar establishments when not in official mission or when the carrying of said firearm is not necessary inside said premises.
