RESOLUTION NO. SP-1349, S-2000

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR REPRESENTING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE METRO MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY QUEZON CITY FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE PAYATAS DUMPSITE.

WHEREAS, under the law, the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) is tasked with solid waste disposal/management in Metro Manila, particularly the establishment and operation of sanitary landfill stations;

WHEREAS, pending the establishment of an adequate sanitary landfill station for the disposal of wastes in Quezon City and neighboring towns/cities, the Quezon City government is operating and maintaining, at its own expense, a dumpsite at the Payatas area;

WHEREAS, it is but fair and equitable that the City be compensated/reimbursed by the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) for such expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable City Mayor representing the Quezon City government to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Metro Manila Development Authority for the reimbursement of expenses incurred by Quezon City for the maintenance and operation of the Payatas dumpsite, the cost of which shall be compensated/reimbursed by the MMDA subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. That the MMDA shall reimburse the expenses incurred by the Quezon City government in the operation and maintenance of the Payatas dumpsite, such as the costs of chemicals/deodorizers, bulldozers and payloader rentals and road maintenance to include soil cover in the amount of Thirty Two Pesos and Forty-One Centavos (P32.41) per cubic meter of garbage dumped by the City, as well as the cost of personal services for the maintenance and operation of such dumpsite.

2. That the City shall submit the approved and paid disbursement vouchers and the necessary supporting documents to the MMDA covering its claim for reimbursement, subject to accounting and COA rules and regulations.
3. The City Mayor shall have secured prior authority from the City Council to enter into this MOA as prescribed in the Local Government Code.
4. That this Memorandum of Agreement shall cover the expenses incurred for the period from January 1999 to December 2000.
