RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-4367~~ S-2000

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (142) SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO PROVIDE GROUP PENSION/RETIREMENT BENEFITS TO ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED BARANGAY OFFICIALS INCLUDING LUPON MEMBERS, BARANGAY SECURITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICERS (BSDO's) AND STAFF AND TO PROVIDE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF PREMIUMS WHICH SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE BARANGAY ANNUAL OR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 2000 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER.

WHEREAS, Section 393 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly provides that Barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the Lupon Tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of the Code and during their incumbency shall be entitled to insurance coverage which shall include, but shall not be limited to, temporary and permanent disability, double indemnity accident insurance, death and burial benefits;

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the risk assumed by the barangay officials, tanods and lupon members and other barangay employees, while in the performance of their duties and functions, there is a need to provide necessary protection against death, and injury and appropriate pension/retirement benefits for services rendered;

WHEREAS, of all public servants in the country, barangay officials and employees are the ones given least priority in terms of benefits and privileges, particularly the volunteers who are rendering public and community service, thus the giving of group pension/retirement benefits is one way of recognizing their unselfish effort and great contribution to community development and nation building;

WHEREAS, barangays in highly urbanized areas financially capable of allocating certain funds in its annual and supplemental budgets, if properly authorized, can set aside amount to defray premium expenses for group insurance that will redound to the benefit of all barangay officials and employees;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the One Hundred Forty-Two (142) Sangguniang Barangays in Quezon City to provide group pension/retirement benefits to all elected and appointed barangay officials including lupon members, BSDO's, and staff and to provide necessary funds for the payment of premiums which shall be included in the Barangay Annual or Supplemental Budget for the Year 2000, and every year thereafter.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the City Budget Officer, the City Accountant, the City Treasurer and the Fiscal Control Audit Office shall assist the Punong Barangays and Barangay Treasurers in the implementation of this authority for pension/retirement benefits.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the City Council shall furnish copy of this resolution to the One Hundred Forty-Two (142) Sangguniang Barangays for their information and appropriate action.
