RESOLUTION NO. SP ~~1371~~ 2000

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CONGRESSMAN RODOLFO T. TIAZON, CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS, INCLUDING THE FOUR (4) CONGRESSMEN OF QUEZON CITY TO FILE A BILL AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4136, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRAFFIC CODE, PARTICULARLY SECTION 5, ARTICLE I, CHAPTER II THEREOF, SO AS TO REQUIRE MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERS TO PRESENT THE CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CERTIFICATE OBTAINED FROM THE BARANGAY OF THEIR RESIDENCE TO THE CONCERNED LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) TO THE EFFECT THAT THEY HAVE AVAILABLE PARKING SPACE WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THEIR RESIDENCE FOR THE MOTOR VEHICLES SOUGHT TO BE REGISTERED BY THEM.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that most traffic jams in the metropolis, including Quezon City, are caused by illegally parked motor vehicles whose owners do not have parking spaces for their vehicles;

WHEREAS, moreover, most city streets get congested due to indiscriminate parking of motor vehicles, thus resulting to practically closing to traffic said streets;

WHEREAS, in order to decongest the city streets and those of the entire metropolis and, thus, ease the flow of traffic, there is a need to amend Section 5, Article I, Chapter II of R. A. 4136, as amended, otherwise known as the Land Transportation and Traffic Code;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request as it does hereby request, the Honorable Congressman Rodolfo T. Tuazon, Chairman of the Committee on Transportation and Communications, including the four (4) Congressmen of Quezon City, to file a bill amending Republic Act No. 4136, as amended, otherwise known as the Land Transportation and Traffic Code, particularly Section 5, Article I, Chapter II thereof, so as to require motor vehicle owners to present the corresponding barangay certificate obtained from the barangay of their residence to the concerned Land Transportation Office (LTO) to the effect that they have available parking space within the premises of their residence for the motor vehicles sought to be registered by them.
